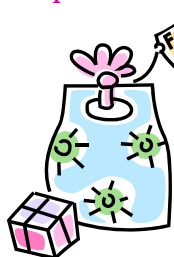

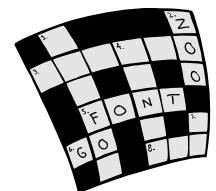

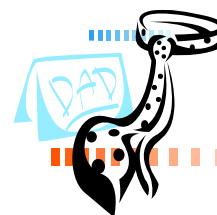
# What Is A Dad?
