MOTHERS DAY POEMS

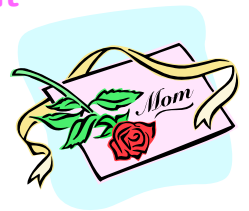
M - O - T - H - E - R
