But what a difference we could make

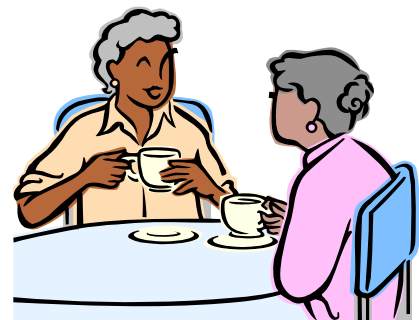
To someone's lonely day ,

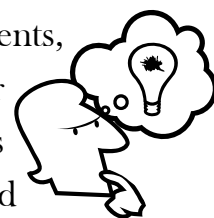
