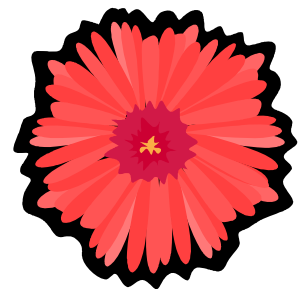
Welcome
